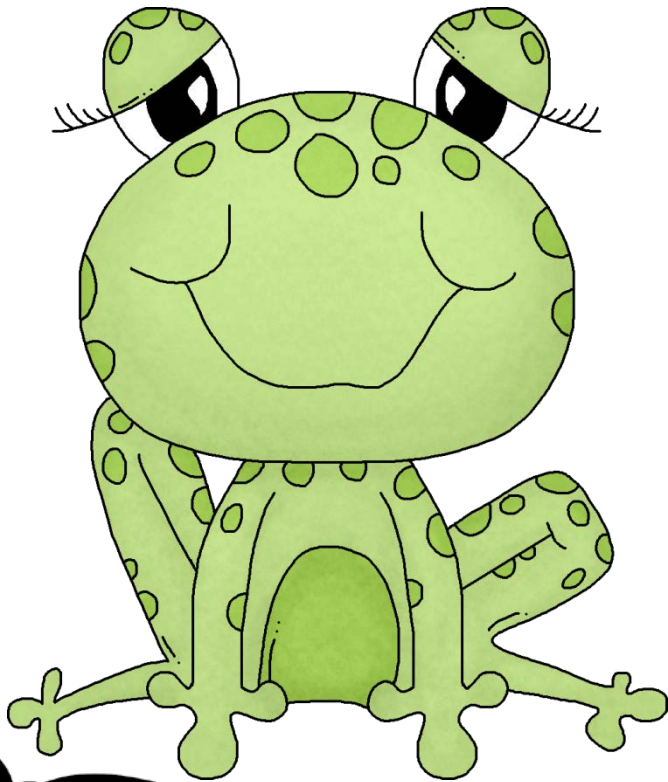


Cause and Effect

happens.

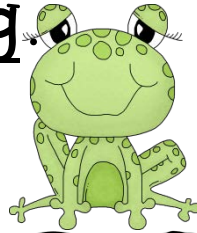


Effect

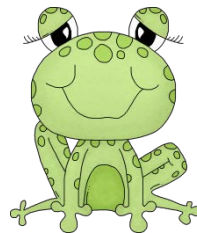

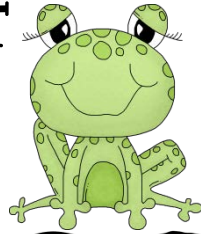

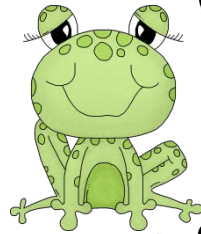
